
#1 SAILS

1. Prepare the material for sails - eliminate unevenness. Using the template from Your model draw the outer line of the sail.




- 2. Using the template, prepare the lines on the sail to imitate the brit.
- To make it use a pencil (hardness B/B1 depends from the thicknes of material).

Measure and draw line by line, remeber to sharp the the pencil to have the same thickness of the line.

3. Reverse the sail and draw lines in the same places like on the first side. To make it easier you can use a glass to have a good view of the first lines.



4. Cut out the sail using the outer line.



5. Prepare a rope matched to the scale of the model and sail.

To remove the small hair on the rope you can use nitro varnich - dip the line in the varnich and remove the excess from the line. Line will be more stiff without small hair and easier to fit.



6. Stick the line to the edge of the sail using nitro varnich.
